All 19 Milwaukee County municipalities require the owners of cats and dogs to license their pets each year.

Licenses are good from January 1st - December 31st and must be renewed annually.

Licensing Fees: (Before March 31st)

Altered Dog or Cat: \$12 Intact Dog or Cat: \$24

(April 1st -December 31st)

Altered Dog or Cat: \$18 Intact Dog or Cat: \$36

Puppies and kittens must be licensed at 5 months old.

After July 1st each year, puppies and kittens have the following fees: Altered Puppy or Kitten \$6 Intact Puppy or Kitten \$12

## Why get a license?

License tags for dogs and cats work the same as a driver's license works for the rest of us.

Each tag corresponds with your contact information that we keep on file and provide to MADACC Animal Control Officers or local law enforcement if we find your dog or cat when it is away from home without you.

This allows us to reach you and reunite you with your lost pet within minutes of finding them!

License tags also provide proof that your pet is vaccinated against rabies, which means they are in compliance with state law.
